Permanent Barrier

WHEREAS, to achieve, maintain and protect human health and safety, foster the comfort of the residents of the City of Ridgeside ("City") and to prevent and remove nuisances; and,

WHEREAS, to protect the residents from potential hazardous conditions, prevent unrestricted access by motorized vehicles, and or foot traffic, except via designated streets, and provide additional safety and security for the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City in session assembled that:

The Commissioners have determined through several community meetings in homes of residents that the City may install permanent barriers on the following street.

1.3 Lynncrest Drive at the intersection of Tunnel Boulevard

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any section , subsection, sentence, word or figure contained in this ordinance should be declared invalid by a final decree of a court of competent jurisdiction such holding shall not affect the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, words or figures contained in this ordinance, but the same shall remain in full force and effect.

Permanent Barriers

WHEREAS, to achieve, maintain and protect human health and safety, foster the comfort of the residents of the City of Ridgeside ("City") and to prevent and remove nuisances; and,

WHEREAS, to protect the residents from potential hazardous conditions, prevent unrestricted access by motorized vehicles, and or foot traffic, except via designated streets, and provide additional safety and security for the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City in session assembled that:

The City may install temporary barriers for street closures in order to more fully understand the impact on safety and security.

After an evaluation period, and consideration of input from the citizens the City may install permanent barriers on the following streets:

- 1.1 Lynncrest Drive service alley at the intersection of Tunnel Boulevard
- 1.2 North Seminole Road at or near the Ridgeside property line

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any section , subsection, sentence, word or figure contained in this ordinance should be declared invalid by a final decree of a court of competent jurisdiction such holding shall not affect the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, words or figures contained in this ordinance, but the same shall remain in full force and effect.
